**1. General (Times 11, bold )**

All interested participants are kindly invited to present the latest results of their scientific work in one of the ICPIG subject areas.

The deadline for submissions is **15 May, 2007**. After receipt, the submitted papers will be processed at once, on a first come-first served basis. The Local Organizing Committee will do their best to give notify the participant of the final decision on the revised paper within two weeks after receipt. Thus, early submission is encouraged.

Contributed, full-length papers must be written in English and should report previously unpublished work. The authors are responsible for both the content and style of their contributions. No editing or re-typing will be carried out by the conference organisers, and accepted contributions will be reproduced without reduction or modification. Contributions that do not conform to the format described below may be rejected.

Each contributed paper must be submitted in two files:

(a) A Microsoft Word (alternatively Open Office or Rich Text) and its corresponding pdf file, or

(b) A Latex file and their corresponding PDF file.

Please note that the maximum size of the PDF file is limited to 1.2 MB.

The gate for uploading the contributions through the conference website will be opened from 5 January 2, 2009.

Submission by ordinary e-mail will also be acceptable. Please send both Word/pdf or Latex/pdf files as an e-mail attachment to

Contributions submitted by Fax or Postal mail will not be accepted

All abstracts will be printed on a booklet that will be distributed to all registered participants at the start of the conference. All papers presented at the conference will be available on a Compact Disc.

In order to have a paper published in the conference proceedings, at least one of the authors must have paid the registration fee before 15 June, 2009. (Please note that the **early** registration deadline is 15 May, 2009).

Each registered participant is entitled to submit a maximum of two contributed papers.

**2. Recommendations for the text**

**2.1. Format**

Full length papers (up to 4 pages) should be typewritten for **A4/Letter** format paper, with a minimum length of 2 full pages per paper, including figures and references. After the abstract, please use Times New Roman font at two columns.

Set the margins as

**2.2. Miscellaneous**

The topic number (according to the Scientific Programme) must be written on the top right corner of the first page.

### **2.3. Figures, tables and equations**

Papers may include figures and tables. A caption should be written under each figure and above each table. Equation numbers must be in parentheses and placed flush with right-hand margin of the column.

The pages must not be numbered.

List all references at the end of the paper. When referring to them in the text, type the corresponding reference number inside brackets [1] and the reference listed as in the following example:
